Roundtrip Cruise

Friday, October 14 and Saturday, October 16, 2011

This trip involves a six-hour cruise on Friday, October 14 from Louisville, Kentucky to Madison, Indiana aboard the *Belle of Louisville* and a six-hour return cruise from Madison, Indiana to Louisville, Kentucky on Sunday, October 16th. A boxed dinner and musical entertainment are included in both legs of the cruise and a charter bus from and to Madison is offered. The cost is \$130. Cruise times are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for the Friday trip and 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. for the Sunday return trip.

One-Way Cruise to Madison, Indiana

Friday, October 14, 2011

This is a six-hour cruise from Louisville, Kentucky to Madison, Indiana aboard the *Belle of Louisville* with a boxed lunch, musical entertainment and charter bus to Louisville from Madison. The cost is \$80. Cruise time is 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
